AAUW national membership dues are \$49. \$46 is tax deductible as a charitable contribution, and \$3 not deductible because it supports the AAUW Action Funds Section 501(c)(4) Lobby Corps and get-out-the-vote activities.

Student Affiliate dues are \$17, \$16 is tax deductible, \$1 is not deductible; AAUW National Life Membership is \$980 fully tax deductible.

Note: Branch/state portions of dues are not tax deductible unless your branch/state is classified under the Section 501(c)(3) status directly with the Internal Revenue Service

National Dues, Fees, and Tax Deductibility

Explanation of Terms

Full-year dues:

Collect between March 16 and December 31. The membership expires June 30 of the next year.

Half-year dues:

Available only to new members. Collect between January 1 and March 15. The membership expires June 30 of the current year.

Transfer:

A member leaving one branch to join another or a national member (formerly member-at-large) who joins a branch is a transfer member, not a new member, unless they only recently joined. If expire year is 2014, national dues are \$49. If expire year is 2015 or later, national dues are \$0.

College/University Representative:

A faculty or staff named by the AAUW college/university partner member to serve as the liaison between the school and AAUW. This person may not be the same person who holds the position of college/university relations officer in your branch. Please make this clarification.

Dual Member:

A member of multiple branches holds dual membership. The branch that collects national dues is considered the primary branch. Any additional branch memberships are considered the dual branches and only collect the branch and state dues from the member. State dues should only be collected once a year per state.

Branch recruitment campaigns such as Shape the Future and half-years dues are for new members only. A new member is someone entirely new to AAUW or lapsed for two years or more. National members (formerly MALs) are not new members to AAUW but “transfers” when they join a branch. E-mail connect@aauw.org or call 800/326-2289 to verify the status of any former/national member.

The membership year runs July 1 through June 30 for branches and college/university partners. National members (formerly MALs) run one year from your anniversary.
